- Fundraising for clubs will be with Boosters.

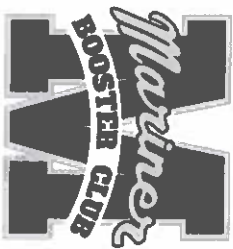
4. Booster Activities

- Concessions Progress Report:
